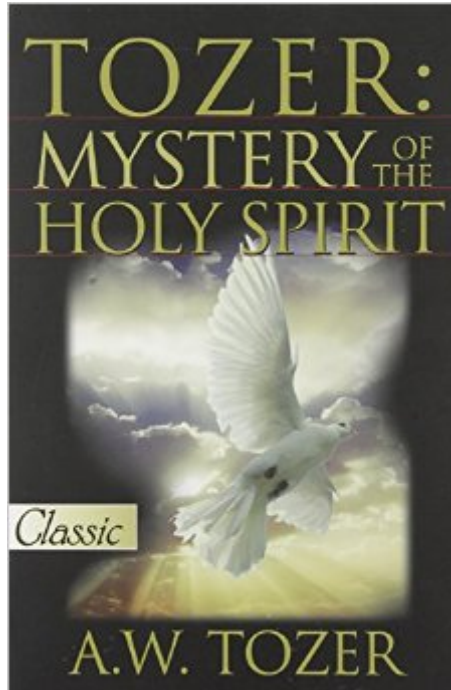

MYSTERY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT is a collection of sermons delivered by A.W. Tozer about the Holy Spirit: who He is, what He is like, how to know Him, how to be filled with Him and other truths. Mature believers will relish these delectable treasures as Tozer clearly and compellingly whets the appetite to know more of Him. Tozer knew of whom he spoke. He was deeply and fully acquainted with the Holy Spirit and writes with the breath-taking candor and clarity of one who knows his subject intimately. Tozer is not bashful about speaking his mind, especially when it concerns the modern church: "We expect [to live our lives] and we just want the Lord to have the chariot ready when we are ready to die." "Some people consider church to be a social place with spiritual

overtone. It is not. It is a spiritual place with social overtones."Tozer speaks longingly, even achingly of fellowship with the Holy Spirit:"The Holy Spirit is a living person. And as He is a living person, you can know Him and fellowship with Him; whisper to Him and have His voice whisper back to you in some love text that you know, or some love hymn, and whisper back to you, so that walking with the Spirit can become a habit with you."And of Jesus Christ:"Oh, that voice of the Shepherd, tender as a lullaby, strong as a wind and as mighty as the sound of many waters. The voice of Jesus, that healing, musical, solemn, beautiful voice of Jesus in His church." "Nobody loves the world quite enough. The man who loved the world enough to die for it, died for it."And of the saints:"Everybody has as much of God as he desires to have." "We need a loneliness for God..."The editor, James Snyder writes that this book sends the reader first to his knees and then to our Bibles.

This book is a collection of ten or so of Tozer's sermons on the Holy Spirit. They're ordered in a logical progression; each builds a better understanding of the Holy Spirit and our relationship with Him. Read this book slowly, and not all at once! Each chapter should be digested, and you should have your Bible next to you as you read this book. I've thoroughly enjoyed this book, now reading through it a second time. It helps me understand so much about the Holy Spirit, teaching I had never heard in church or Bible study. Tozer's prose is hard hitting and, at times, even amusing, and he conveys his message well.

A must read for all those seeking to learn and know more about the Third PERSON of the Godhead. Tozer does not wax eloquent in this book, but his "speaking voice" still carries sound Biblical and foundational teaching necessary, at a time in Church History, in which, the Holy Spirit is often presented as one who embraces every kind of fanaticism now running the gamut in Pentecostal circles.

I LOVE all of Tozer's writings but I am so in love with Holy Spirit and the relevance this book sheds on Him. I will read it again and again as there are many golden nuggets to be found. My prayer life has become more in such that I include Holy Spirit more a part of my conversations with God and I am really beginning to learn secret things in my secret place with the Lord. I hear Him and many times I don't need to speak, Holy Spirit shows me my heart and all the many prayers in it and He speaks as He listens.

I bought this book to learn more about the Holy Spirit and to "dive deeper." This book was well worth

reading. It was compelling and kept me turning the pages. Tozer is challenging and inciteful. It's a book that can easily be read in a few days, but the content of the book is so thought provoking and "meaty" that it must be put down and thought through, so it takes longer to read in order to digest all that he is feeding you. This is a sermon written down for a book and I found myself hearing it preached from a pulpit as I was reading it. If you are looking for a challenge as well as a good read, then this is a book for you. Dive Deeper!

Tozer's book speaks to your heart about the reality of the Holy Spirit of God. He uses simple stories to touch your heart but his theme is weighty. He opens God's Word in a way that I have not seen in many books and he gave me many things to think about that totally changed my perspective about God, Christ and The Holy Spirit. If you want to deepen your spirituality and learn more about the Holy Spirit and draw closer to Christ, then this book will help you find out more about your own beliefs and those of the early Christians. I highly recommend it.

Tozer was a great man of God. He was a prophet in his day and tells us much about the Holy Spirit and how the Spirit works and deals with us - and also, why we don't necessarily have the Holy Spirit working in our lives. It is a must-have for anyone sincerely interested in receiving the entire teaching of the Holy Spirit. Modern Christians don't have the slightest idea of how the Holy Spirit works in the life of the believer! I wouldn't be without this book.

A.W. Tozer informs us that when we speak of the Holy Spirit, we are speaking of the Trinity. The Holy Spirit is very much alive, we need to take the time to get to know the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is seeking our friendship, like a friend we need to give in order to get to know them. I love Tozer because he is "old school". He does not tolerate fluff and frill. You want to become a better person, read, study and contemplate his writings and sermons. There are none like him. You will change the way you think when read and get to know one of the great religious minds.
