

This is a nice board book for younger children that takes them along a train journey to some of America's National Parks. Not only does it mention the parks, Acadia, Great Smoky Mountains, Rocky Mountain, Grand Teton, Grand Canyon, Yellowstone, Zion, Yosemite and Olympic, it has pictures of some animals, some activities in those parks and at the end of the book, it has a map showing where the parks are located and animal prints. The aesthetic is great, however the content is a little disappointing. There's just not much to it. My 1 and 3 year old daughters were equally unimpressed. So I'd recommend as nursery decor, but not as a quality book.

Art is wonderful but there isnt really much to read. Each page basically has a caption and a labled animal.
