

I found the book to be well-organized and -written however as someone already comfortable using most of the built in functions within V6R1 ILE RPG I was hoping for tips that would help me move to a more advanced level of ILE RPG & functions. If you're relatively new to ILE RPG development or aren't comfortable using functions, this would be a good reference to get more out of them. If you've been using ILE RPG and functions for several years, you'll likely find this text to be a bit light. The sections on C functions and programming style are nice additions and overall this would make a good reference guide for the shop trying to develop programming standards. I intend to share my copy around the office as a mentoring tool.
