

The author explains that not only do we as Christians have authority, most of us do not know about it or even how to use it. Once we are aware of this authority, we will be able to do the work God has called us to do. This is book consists of only 70 pages but each page is packed with power and scripture.

This book is the 1984 revised edition of the book that was originally written in 1967. In the Preface, Kenneth Hagin Jr. wrote that "Dad has gained even more light on the subject of spiritual authority. He often said he wished this book could contain these insight." Hence, this is the expanded version which I think is a great book from the Word of Faith movement. I believe that what begin as the Word of Faith movement has gained maturity and balance. In fact, Hagin writes, "It's easy to get into the ditch on either side of the road - the excess, wild fire, and fanaticism. Let's go down the middle of the road and maintain balance." (pg. 18)I recommend this book to you, and just as I have been blessed, so will you. As Hagin wrote about the spiritual authority of the believer, I would like to add in his quotation of James 4:17 the first part which was not quoted, i.e. Submit to God. Hagin quotes, "resist the devil, and he will flee from you." I believe that spiritual authority comes from a heart submitted to God and living a life of obedience to Him. Also, a man with authority is a man under authority. In the reading of the book, you can imply these truths from what was written.
