

While the book lays out John Wesley's church structure that brought revival to England and North America in the 1700's. And it still works if you work it!The book includes questions at the end of each chapter for discussion. It also includes a large study guide at the end which is more appropriate for high schoolers.While it refers to the Methodist denomination many times, that denomination is in decline because they have abandoned the principles laid out in this book.

The book is very good for anyone interested in Wesleyan theology. It gives you a basic theology of John Wesley which can change you and the church in general. Good read.

This relatively brief history of John Wesley and his movement covers the time and society in which Wesley lived, and his effort to meet the religious and other needs of that time, as well as how that has developed into the Methodist church in the United States. It also includes guides on using this as an individual or group study. It is not excessively sugar coated, it includes some of the difficulties as well as the successes for both Wesley and the movement he founded, This is well worth your time.

Yrigoyen lays out Wesley's patterns and theology in clear language that helps us to understand more deeply what it means to be a Christian in the Methodist tradition.
